Start From The Village (Gram Theke Shuru)

Objective

The objective of this project is to provide monetary help to a few excessively needy villagers to live a better life.

Specifically, the project will involve in the following 3 categories: First two are under Development categories and the third one is under Education category.

1. Buy cows, goats, poultry, etc. to needy families. The animals will be used as a source of income for the family.
2. Provide money to poor villagers to build and re-build their houses.
3. Give monthly stipend* to a few best academic students (both boys and girls) studying in the local schools based on need basis.

Category 1 : 2 best students (one boy and one girl) from the graduating Class of Nine (IX), Scholarship will be 350 Taka per month for a period of one year

Category II: 2 best students (one boy and one girl) from the graduating Class of Eight (VIII), Scholarship will be 300 Taka per month for a period of one year

* The sponsor may add more scholarships or other form of help to schools (like computer, equipments etc..) later depending on the success and recommendations of SpaandanB EC and the feed back from the Head Masters.

The sponsor (only myself and Dora) believes that the distribution of donation will be mainly on the Development aspect and approximately 80% or more. The rest will be in the Education area.
